
ENABLING WORKS

From Monday 17 October, we will be carrying out enabling works for the new building development (F1 and F2) at Wood Wharf located south of Blackwall Basin, see map below.

The works will involve the construction of a cofferdam, a sheet piled wall and secant wall which will support the new building structures and the new jetty. The piling which accompanies these works will regrettably cause some disruption, but we have taken a number of steps to try to minimise this to our neighbours.

We want to reassure our local community that the team will work to reduce noise disruption caused by the works. As control measures, acoustic barriers will be employed where possible to minimise nuisance at source, vehicle engines will be fitted with white noise reversing alarms and are turned off when not in use, and continued noise monitoring will be undertaken throughout the works to ensure the ambient noise is kept to minimum. Where hammering of the sheet piles is required, works will be limited to 3 hours per day.

We continue to work within the core hours of 8am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am – 1pm on Saturdays as per our Section 61 consent from the London Borough of Tower Hamlets.





7 BRANNAN STREET

The 7 Brannan Street site (F1) is located on the southern edge of the Blackwall Basin, and was previously identified as a location for a residential building within the masterplan. We intend to bring forward a new stand-alone planning application for this building to provide student accommodation. The introduction of student accommodation will complement the mix of uses already on Wood Wharf and is supported by existing infrastructure, public open spaces, retail and entertainment.

We carried out public consultation on the initial designs in August and September, the materials were available online and at two in-person events at Harbord Square. We are currently in the process of preparing an application for submission to Tower Hamlets Council towards the end of 2022. Full details of the proposals are available at:



CONSTRUCT YOURSELF

The Construct Yourself programme is an initiative to support young people with employment and skills within the construction industry. This scheme was launched in collaboration with Canary Wharf Contractors, East London Business Alliance (ELBA), WorkPath and Employment Education Training Group (EETG).

As part of the programme, six residents of Tower Hamlets were provided with training around employability skills over two weeks where they were equipped with all the necessary tools to enter the world of work, followed by free CSCS (Construction Skills Certification Scheme) training.

Five of the trainees successfully completed the training and received their CSCS card, which is a great demonstration and testament to qualify that they have the appropriate skills and qualifications to work on a construction site.

During the two weeks, six employees from Canary Wharf Contractors volunteered to plan and deliver an insightful visit of ongoing development projects in Canary Wharf. The group of trainees were able to hear from the trade staff directly of their experiences at work and witnessed the stages of the groundworks of a construction project, through to a site near completion.

A few contractors from the Wood Wharf project such as Munnellys, O'Halloran and O'Brian, and Essex Services Group welcomed trainees to work on site alongside their qualified and experienced staff in structural concrete, multiservices, logistics, and mechanical and electrical works. After two weeks of onthe-job work experience, the trainees were offered interviews for permanent jobs. Three trainees subsequently received job offers and look forward to careers within the construction industry. **ELBA and Canary Wharf Contractors look** forward to delivering further Construct Yourself programmes, contributing to positively changing individuals' lives.
