

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



8 HARBORD SQUARE (G7)

8 Harbord Square (Building G7) is progressing on programme to complete at the end of the year. 8 Harbord Square are loft style apartments which are available for sale. The removal of the scaffolding is well progressed and will be fully removed in March revealing the amazing brickwork façades. Internal fitting out is progressing on all levels with flooring, kitchens and bathrooms currently being installed.

3 & 15 WEST LANE (G1 & G5)

3 and 15 West Lane (Buildings G1 and G5) will reach a key milestone in February with the structure completed, topping out the buildings. 3 and 15 West Lane are serviced apartments. The brickwork is due to commence in February along with deliveries of the first bathroom pod.

ONE CARTIER CIRCLE (B2)

The installation of the modular rooms has recommenced at the One Cartier Circle (Building B2) serviced apartments. The modular rooms were manufactured off site, and we should see a steady flow of modules being craned into place over the next 6 months with our new contractor, M-AR Off-Site Construction.

40 & 50-60 CHARTER STREET (E3/E4 & J1-J3)


The basement structure for 40 and 50-60 Charter Street (Buildings E3/E4 and J1-J3) is nearing completion. 40 and 50-60 Charter Street are apartments that will form part of our Vertus rental portfolio. The construction of the concrete cores can now be seen coming above ground floor level with the floor slabs to follow. The next key element of work is the cladding installation commencing in the summer.



7 AND 13 BRANNAN STREET (F1 &F2)

The enabling works at 7 and 13 Brannan Street (Buildings F1 and F2) commenced in October 2022. This consists of forming a new sheet pile dock wall and a cofferdam to reclaim a section of the dock for the Building F1 plot within Blackwall Basin. The enabling works will be taking place over the course of 2023 with piling to commence before the end of the year. We are installing sheet piles for the building F1 which will sit on the dock edge. When completed Blackwall Basin will have new pontoons with riverboat moorings available. We thought it might be helpful to share a schedule of these works:

- We will be using a silent piling machine to complete the sheet piling for a period of 6-8 weeks. The silent piler is a lot less obtrusive in terms of noise but there is a strong chance the hammer will be needed daily to drive the sheets to the required toe level if the Giken cannot achieve the required levels. We have a dispensation from LBTH for a maximum 3 hours a day hammering which we will be monitoring carefully.
- Following this, we commence with Secant piling running through to July 2023.
- We do not expect to undertake any piling following this until the building piles commence. This is currently scheduled for October 2023 (8 weeks) and February 2024 (8 weeks).
- We are making every effort to get these works completed swiftly and with the least disruption possible.



REDUCING WASTE AND EMISSIONS

We are committed to reducing waste and emissions, over the past few months we have been working hard with our trade contractors to make improvements. Here's a few examples:

Our concrete trade contractors O'Halloran & O'Brien, who are working on the J1/J3 and E3/E4 projects, have linked their fuel bowser to a smart fuel management system. This system allows the team to monitor the real-time consumption and change behaviours towards fuel use on site. We have replaced diesel powered plant on site with electric plant on our F1 and F2 projects

Our contractor Bachy Soletanche are using EcoSheet piles as part of their construction process. These have been created from recycled metal and manufactured using renewable energy.
