

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



7 AND 13 BRANNAN STREET (F1 & F2)

With the enabling works at 7 and 13 Brannan Street (Buildings F1 and F2), we encountered adverse ground conditions which required extra hammer piling to complete the piling, all of which was carried out via agreement with LBTH and within our noise and working hours constraints. We are continuing with the sheet pile dock wall installation and are aiming to complete in May 2023.

Following this, we will dewater and reclaim a small area of the dock which will enable us to form a new secant piled wall for 7 Brannan Street's basement structure. Building piles for 13 Brannan Street are due to commence in October 2023 and the team are busy with the enabling works to meet this milestone.

ONE CARTIER CIRCLE (B2)

The install of modular apartments is continuing to progress at One Cartier Circle (building B2). The modular apartments are manufactured off site and travel down from Hull where they are craned into place. We recently landed our 100th module by new contractor M-AR Off Site Construction.

BIODIVERSITY AT WOOD WHARF

Protecting and enhancing biodiversity is one of Canary Wharf's key sustainability focus areas. Biodiversity supports everything in nature that we need to survive. The World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF) defines biodiversity as "all the different kinds of life you'll find in one area – the variety of animals, plants, fungi and microorganisms".

There is more to biodiversity in Canary Wharf than meets the eye. Over at Wood Wharf we have a variety of animals and plants living together on the development, and we want to make sure these species continue to thrive. A few of our enhancements include:

- Installing bird nesting features such as nest boxes and nest tubes
- Creating biodiverse green and brown roofs
- Creating aquatic habitats such as ecological islands
- Installing bat boxes

As part of our ongoing effort to support the biodiversity on the Wood Wharf development, our ecological consultants, Greengage, will be undertaking surveys over the next few months. You may see the Greengage team at different hours of the day (3am – 7am or 7pm -11pm) listening for the male bird mating calls or looking at trees and structures.

We have also now entered the bird nesting season. We have been briefing our construction teams what to do if they spot nesting birds in Wood Wharf. We have spotted various birds on the Wood Wharf development such as:

- · Black red starts
- · Coots
- · Common terns
- Wrens
- Robins




OPEN DOORS
